This warm and embracing wine is called “Ulysse” in honour of the ancient legend where Ulysse landed in this part of Sicily. This wine is still produced from grapes grown in small vineyards scattered around the slopes of the Etna.

GRAPE VARIETY

Nerello Mascalese and Nerello Cappuccio

TERRITORY OF ORIGIN

DOC area on the slopes of the volcano Etna

TERROIR

Soil composition: volcanic, rich in mineral and organic matter.

Altitude: 600m above sea level.

Climate: high mountain with a high level of brightness and wide temperature ranges.

VINIFICATION AND AGEING

Traditional, long thermo-controlled maceration, refining in small oak chestnut casks of 25hl and at least 2 month in bottle.

TASTING NOTES

Colour: ruby red with garnet reflections.

Aroma: intense and persistent with hints of red fruits and spices. Redcurrant, plum, cloves and vanilla.

Flavour: dry, soft and well-balanced.

PAIRING

Grilled meat, boiled stews. Serve at 16°-18° C.
